

become self-reliant and independent. He achieves his own happiness by pursuing his own chosen career and creating his own private wealth. As a principled individualist he practices *authentic benevolence*, which is discussed in the chapter entitled "Reclaiming America's Founding Principles and Ideals." The ruling elite seeks to use the Communist moral code, including the "spirit of community" and collectivist principles, to destroy the concept of the free, independent individual, to make people dependent wards of the state, to degrade them and make them submissive to governmental Authority.

#### V. The Communists Add a New Dimension to Dr. Frankenstein's Demonic Experiment—The Specter of Terror

### **The U.S. and Communist Ruling Elites: Exploiting the Specter of Terrorism**

Like the Clinton-Gore administration, the Bush administration has formed "strategic relationships" with Russia and Red China. On January 29, 2002, President Bush stated, "America is working with Russia and China...in ways we have never before...." To "combat terrorism," the Bush administration has created a coalition which includes these two Communist totalitarian police states. On June 16, 2001, during a press conference by President George W. Bush and Russian President Vladimir Putin, President Bush said, "We share a lot of values." "I looked the man in the eye.... I was able to get a sense of his soul...." "[O]ur relationship is larger than just security relationships.... It deals with two leaders who share values." Indeed, both leaders seek to advance the values and ethics of communitarianism and environmentalism. Furthermore, Putin is the former head of Russia's KGB/FSB, which is in essence a terrorist organization made up of murderous Marxist-Leninist criminals. The CFR-dominated Bush administration has sought to cooperate with the Putin regime to achieve world communitarianism/Communism.

In the December 31, 2001 issue of *The New American*, William F. Jasper writes, "Russia, China, Syria, Iran, Pakistan, Yemen, and other states we are embracing as 'allies' against terrorism have been the prime sponsors of terrorism for decades and have been key supporters of bin Laden and his extended network up to the present time. In sharing intelligence, military training, and technology with these 'allies,' we are guaranteeing that they will be able to keep a steady stream of 'bin Ladens' rolling off the assembly line" and assisting them to a greater extent "in carrying out even more sophisticated and more deadly acts of terror against us."<sup>164</sup>

This book shows that Communism has now reached the final stage of its development in the United States and in the world. This is evidenced by growing terrorism at home and abroad. The U.S. and Communist ruling elites seek to exploit the specter of terrorism. Terrorism serves their interests. They can manipulate human thought and behavior. They can make people accept and do things that they wouldn't tolerate in normal times. The Communists believe that a certain amount of terror must be engendered in the people, so they will then feel fearful and powerless and will take immediate orders, completely and unquestionably. In the name of protecting the public, our leaders can issue decrees; they can gain passage of anti-terrorism laws that suppress or abridge the liberties of the people. In fact, the destruction of all rights and all freedoms and the imposition of a police state are the aims of terrorist revolutionaries and their sponsors.

## The United Nations: Supported by the Marxist-Leninist Mass Murderers and Sponsors of Terrorism and by Their Allies—America's Global Leaders

On February 1, 1992, President George H. Bush addressed the UN General Assembly: "It is the sacred principles enshrined in the United Nations Charter to which the American people will henceforth pledge their allegiance."

On March 14, 2002, President George W. Bush stated, "America supports the international development goals in the U.N. Millennium Declaration...."

Americans should be cognizant of the statements that appear in the United Nations Millennium Declaration, some of which are presented here:

"...We, heads of State and Government, have gathered at United Nations Headquarters in New York from 6 to 8 September 2000...." "...We reaffirm our commitment to the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations...."

"...We resolve...to ensure compliance by Member States with the decisions of the International Court of Justice, in compliance with the Charter of the United Nations...."

"...We reaffirm our support for the principles of sustainable development, including those set out in Agenda 21...."

"...[W]e resolve: • To make every effort to ensure the entry into force of the Kyoto Protocol...."

In 1944, U.S. State Department official Alger Hiss (CFR), who was a secret Soviet agent, and Joseph Stalin's Foreign Minister, Vyacheslav Molotov, officially wrote the initial draft of the UN Charter. Hiss was Secretary-General of the International Assembly which created the United Nations. Stalin was a sadistic, megalomaniacal, Marxist-Leninist dictator and architect of Terror who ordered the death of millions of human beings. He had a lust for absolute power and an insatiable desire for Soviet expansion. Stalin, as well as every subsequent Soviet leader, has been not only a Marxist-Leninist mass murderer, but a political propagandist and supporter of the UN. Soviet leaders have used the UN to spread Marxism-Leninism throughout the world and to advance their drive toward global domination.

In his book, *The Naked Capitalist*, W. Cleon Skousen, a former FBI agent, says, "[T]he United Nations charter was written by a State Department-Soviet Union coalition of strategists who specifically designed the UN so that it could eventually override the sovereign independence of its member nations and subject them to the Marxist-dominated World Court and the Marxist-directed military forces of the United Nations."<sup>165</sup>

"The Charter...provides that membership in the UN shall be restricted to 'peace-loving' states (Article 4)." J. Reuben Clark, former Undersecretary of State, stated, "The Charter is built to prepare for war, not to promote peace.... The Charter is a war document not a peace document...."<sup>166</sup>

"...[T]he United Nations Charter," writes William F. Jasper, "is based on the framework of positivist legal theory which virtually guarantees unrestrained, despotic government.... [T]he UN is a lawless organization made up largely of criminal regimes pursuing a malevolent, tyrannical agenda." Skousen writes, "Anyone familiar with the Communist Constitution of Russia will recognize in the United Nations Charter a similar format."<sup>167</sup>

Russia and Red China—murderous police states and the sponsors of terrorism—have been given special status on the Security Council of the United Nations, which is the world's principal institutional sponsor of terrorism. "[T]he Charter provides in Article 24 that any nation which joins the UN must 'agree to accept and carry out the

decisions of the Security Council." <sup>168</sup> In the February 25, 2002 issue of *The New American*, Steve Bonta writes, "The UN Security Council arrogantly considers itself the lawgiver for the world...."

The CFR-dominated Clinton/Bush administrations have been strong supporters of the UN. In his speech on September 5, 2000, General Colin Powell (CFR) referred to Mikhail Gorbachev, a dedicated Marxist-Leninist, as "an old friend and colleague." Powell said this during his January 17th confirmation hearing: "I have seen what the UN can do over the years. It is a great organization. It is deserving of our support." Recently, on September 12, 2002, in his remarks at the United Nation's Secretary General Luncheon, President Bush said, "The U.N. Charter commits each nation here to promoting social progress and better standards of life in larger freedom." In his address to the United Nations General Assembly on that same day, Bush said, "My nation will work with the U.N. Security Council to meet our common challenge.... The Security Council resolutions will be enforced—the just demands of peace and security will be met...."

"Peace campaigns' have been the standard weapons in the communist arsenal of political and psychological warfare," writes Lyons. Only a Communist who had lost all of his faculties would take them literally. But to ensure that there is no confusion among the faithful, the Communist International at the Moscow Congress in 1928 stated plainly: "The peace policy of the proletarian state certainly does not imply that the Soviet state has become reconciled with capitalism.... It is merely another, and under present conditions, *a more advantageous, form of fighting capitalism.*" In the 1960s, Communist leaders continued to reiterate their position as shown by the following quotation: "Peaceful coexistence...is certainly not a passive process...but an active and intense struggle, in the course of which socialism irresistibly attacks, while capitalism suffers one defeat after another."<sup>169</sup>

### **The Bush Administration: Fighting "A 'War On Terrorism' Through the United Nations"**

The Clinton/Bush Administrations have given their full support to the Communist/KGB-dominated United Nations, an organization whose goals are world government, the creation of a world army, the destruction of American civilization, and the creation of a brutal, terror-breeding, global totalitarian police state.

In the February 25, 2002 issue of *The New American*, William Norman Grigg says that after the September 11th attacks, the Bush administration moved rapidly "to obtain the approval of the UN and its regional affiliate, NATO.... And the UN Security Council passed Resolution 1373, a measure drafted by the Bush administration's UN representative to authorize the 'war on terrorism'.... In seeking permission to take our nation to war, President Bush was willing to defer to the UN Security Council, but not to Congress."

The day following the September 11th attacks, the Security Council put out Resolution 1368, calling on states to "work together urgently to bring to justice the perpetrators, organizers, and sponsors of these attacks" and stated its "readiness to take all necessary steps to respond to the terrorist attacks of 11 September 2001, and to combat all forms of terrorism, in accordance with its responsibilities under the Charter of the United Nations."<sup>170</sup>

The UN Security Council adopted Resolution 1378 on 14 November 2001, which says that it approves of "international efforts to root out terrorism, in keeping with the Charter of the United Nations...." William Norman Grigg had said that on October 8th

"Syria was given a seat on the UN Security Council...." Syria "is listed by the State Department as a sponsor of terrorism."<sup>171</sup> The Bush administration's "war on terrorism" is in fact a campaign being supervised by the United Nations and the real goal is total global government under this gargantuan, KGB/Communist/communitarian-created organization.

"In his address to Congress on September 20th, President Bush declared that world leaders would have to decide whether 'you are with us, or with the terrorists.' By that standard, the October 6th vote [in which the overwhelming majority of the UN General Assembly voted to approve Syria's candidacy to occupy a Security Council seat] shows irrefutably that the UN General Assembly stands with the terrorists." "...[T]he Bush administration...is fighting the 'war on terrorism' under a UN mandate, rather than in the constitutionally prescribed manner...." In January 2002, the Bush administration began to report to a UN Security Council that "includes an acknowledged terrorist regime." Of the five permanent members of the UN, two—Russia and Red China—are the main sponsors of terrorism. Grigg says, "By choosing to fight a 'war on terrorism' through the United Nations, the Bush administration has placed our national defense in the hands of the world's chief institutional sponsor of terrorism."

Russian President Vladimir Putin—former KGB chief, loyal Communist, and dedicated Marxist-Leninist-Stalinist—has become the Bush administration's ally in the war against terrorism. At the same time "Putin's regime was" posing as an important and vital "ally in the 'war on terrorism,'" writes Grigg, "it was putting the finishing touches on a military accord with Iran that will make that Middle Eastern terrorist state Russia's third-largest arms customer behind India and Communist China." Both Iran and Syria are named "on the State Department's roster of terrorist sponsors." In the view of the Iranian nation, the United States is still the "Great Satan." In April, the State Department described Iran as "the most active state sponsor of terrorism in 2000." Iran is a barbaric, Marxist-Leninist totalitarian state.

In the February 11, 2002 issue of *The New American*, the Insider Report states: "Iran's state-run *Tehran Times* reported on January 3rd that Afghanistan's new prime minister, Hamid Karzai, had met the previous day with Iran's deputy foreign minister...to request Iran's help in rebuilding the war-torn country. Karzai thanked Iran for its past categorical support, saying: "We want to see our Iranian brothers involved in every aspect of the reconstruction of Afghanistan."

On January 28, 2002, President George W. Bush said, "The United States strongly supports Chairman Karzai's interim government." In the March 25, 2002 issue of *The New American*, the Insider Report states: "Afghanistan's new Prime Minister Hamid Karzai...thanked Iran for allegedly helping to save his nation from ruin and for its efforts in fighting the 'war on terrorism.' In contrast, President Bush, the man responsible for Karzai's current position, has deemed Iran a member of the terrorist 'axis of evil.'" President Bush's condemnation of Iran helps to conceal the truth from the American people; that is: the Bush administration is the partner of Russia, which is the partner of Iran, and they are *all* pursuing a malevolent, tyrannical globalist agenda.

William F. Jasper writes, "The Russian-Iranian strategic alliance to control Islam and oil has gone almost completely unreported in the establishment press. An essential vehicle in this strategy is the little-known Economic Cooperation Organization (ECO)." In 1964 Iran, Pakistan, and Turkey created the Regional Cooperation for Development (RCD); in 1985 it became active under this new name—ECO. In 1992, ECO had seven new members: Afghanistan, Azerbaijan, Kyrgyzstan, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, and Uzbekistan. Of the ten members just mentioned, the last five are controlled by Soviet-era Communists. The rest are coming more and more under

Russia's influence.

On November 26, 1996, the Iranian Foreign Minister Kamal Kharrazi said in a speech to the Institute for East-West Studies: "Iran and Russia are both partners in three interrelated regions: the Caucasus, Caspian Sea, and Central Asia." "The interests of Iran and Russia in these regions merge together...."

Jasper says, "Within OPEC, Iran has used its ECO" muscle, together "with Russia, to" acquire a great deal of "influence. That has been" helped along through "Tehran's close relations with Hugo Chavez, the Marxist chief of Venezuela, OPEC's second largest oil producer and the main provider of our imported oil. The World Bank, the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development, and other institutions have been pouring billions of dollars into the ECO countries to develop oil and gas reserves and pipelines. They are using our tax dollars to build the lines that our enemies will use to strangle us."<sup>172</sup>

On November 28, 2001, President Bush made a statement on the Caspian Pipeline Consortium. Mr. Bush said, "I congratulate Russia, Kazakhstan, and Oman, and their consortium partners, for the commissioning of the Caspian Pipeline Consortium (CPC).... The CPC project...advances my Administration's National Energy Policy by developing a network of multiple Caspian pipelines.... These projects will help diversify U.S. energy supply and enhance our energy security, while supporting global economic growth." In the May 27, 2002 issue of the American Free Press, Vince Ryan tells about the Bush family's involvement in oil and states: "One confidential report states that gas and oil reserves in Kazakhstan could be worth \$4 trillion, more than in Saudi Arabia."

### **The Bush Administration and the Coalition to Combat Terrorism: Making America the Ally of Terrorist Regimes and of Countries That Sponsor Terrorism**

Red China is also a permanent member of the UN Security Council. William Norman Grigg says that this Communist nation "generously supplied military hardware and assistance to Afghanistan's Taliban junta. And the Northern Alliance, brought to power with the backing of the UN-organized coalition, is a hideous collection of terrorists, drug traffickers, and degenerates that differs from the Taliban only in matters of nuance."<sup>173</sup>

In the December 31, 2001 issue of *The New American*, William F. Jasper states, "Yossef Bodansky's *Bin Laden: The Man Who Declared War on America*, [is] the most comprehensive biography of Osama bin Laden...." Bodansky accurately notes: "Virtually all major and spectacular terrorist strikes are state sponsored, and they are not hasty undertakings. The key perpetrators of these terrorist strikes are...disciplined operatives completely under the control of the intelligence services of the terrorism-sponsoring states." Having provided other crucial facts, Jasper says, "Quite obviously, bin Laden has functioned as a controlled operative of Iran and the intelligence agencies of other countries." It is vital, however, to determine the identity of the "ultimate state sponsors" of terrorism.

In *Terrorism: The Soviet Connection*, Dr. Ray S. Cline, the former deputy director of intelligence for the Central Intelligence Agency and Dr. Yonah Alexander, director of the Institute for Studies in International wrote, "As 1984 begins, the year George Orwell long ago made synonymous with political oppression, the odds increase in favor of Soviet-sponsored revolutionary warfare and spectacular incidents, many of the latter involving Americans."

These experts show that today's international terrorist movement was begun in 1964

when the Soviet Politburo decided to raise the amount it spent on terrorism by one thousand percent. It is vital that Americans grasp why the entire world is becoming more and more Orwellian and who is making it that way. Jasper writes, "...Russia and China continue to build weapons of mass destruction for Iran, Iraq, Pakistan, Syria, and Libya, and to fund, train, arm, and supply 'Islamist' terrorist armies worldwide..."<sup>174</sup>

At the same time, the Bush Administration has declared that Russia and China are partners and allies in the "fight against terrorism." On October 19, 2001, in Shanghai, the following statements were made by President Bush and President Jiang Zemin. President Jiang of China said, "China and the United States are two countries with significant influence in the world. As such, we share common responsibility and interest in...working together with the rest of the international community to combat terrorism." President Bush said, "I've come to Shanghai because China and other Asia Pacific nations are important partners in the global coalition against terror.... And I believe that the United States and China can accomplish a lot when we work together to fight terrorism."

On October 21, 2001, during a press conference in Shanghai, President Bush and Russian President Vladimir Putin discussed progress. President Bush said, "Today the world is building a broad international coalition against terrorism, and Russia is taking a full and responsible role in the coalition." "...I look forward to working with him on a new strategic framework. I also look forward to working with him on ways to encourage the flow of capital from the United States into Russia." President Putin said, "Today, Russian-U.S. cooperation develops smoothly...." Can there be any doubt that the Bush administration seeks to assist the Russians in financing the development of their military-industrial complex and weapons of mass destruction that will be used to cow or intimidate us into submission?

### **The Consequences of Total Global Government Under the UN: Horrifying Atrocities and Campaigns of Annihilation, Enslavement, and Mass Murder**

From the '60s through the '80s, there was abundant evidence showing that the Soviets and Red Chinese were sponsoring global terrorism, but U.S. political leaders did not inform the American people. In 1991, Zbigniew Brzezinski proclaimed the earthshaking news: "Communism is dead!" Totalitarian tyrants, mass murderers, Mafia mobsters, and ruthless KGB agents had suddenly reformed! Now they just needed billions of dollars from the West to implement their plans for "reform" and the development of a free market economy.

In his book, *Between Two Ages*, Brzezinski shows that he is a strong supporter of Marx and Lenin.<sup>175</sup> Marxist-Leninist Communist criminals and their U.S. communitarian allies repeated Brzezinski's propagandistic message over and over so many times that most Americans came to accept it as the truth. The goal of the Communist global elite has been to lull Americans and other populaces into a sense of complacency while it advances its communitarian and environmental agenda, accelerates its massive military build-up, and prepares for the seizure of absolute global authority.

According to an *Associated Press* report on November 18, 2001, Secretary of State Colin Powell said, "A long-term campaign against terrorism will take years, and we'll stick with it." In the January 28, 2002 issue of *The New American*, the Insider Report states: "According to an item in the December 31st-January 7th issue of *Time*, White House aides are preparing for a 50-year war on terrorism." Using the "never-ending threat of terrorism" globalist elites "intend to browbeat us into accepting bigger and

more centralized government and to surrender our precious sovereignty to the United Nations and kindred international organizations."

William Norman Grigg writes, "In his address to the Millennium Forum, Kofi Annan declared that by equipping the United Nations with sovereign powers and bringing the world under its rule, humanity will achieve the 'long dreamed-of age of peace and security.'"176 Global power-lusters define "peace" as the absence of any opposition to the brutal, tyrannical, global Communist totalitarian police state they have sought to establish.

Armed with the Communist moral code, a small tyrannical elite has achieved governmental Power and has committed and continues to commit "democide"—the mass murder of persons and populaces by governments. The death of nearly 170 million defenseless human beings during the twentieth century was the horrifying consequence of absolute governmental Power. Steve Bonta writes, "As we surrender more and more of our political and economic sovereignty and freedom to the United Nations and kindred internationalist organizations, we will increasingly see our religion, morals, and way of life under attack by this same gang of megalomaniacal internationalists.... [T]hey will insist on attacking and destroying our families, our churches, and our culture as well, inasmuch as these institutions pose a threat to their long-term design of world domination." They will replace Christianity with paganism and demand that love of God give way to worship of the ecosystem. Self-discipline, marriage, and the traditional nuclear family will give way to licentiousness and moral depravity.<sup>177</sup> They have repeatedly asserted that they will use compulsion to deal with dissenters, i.e., imprisonment, torture, and execution.

### **The Bush Administration, the United Nations, and the Shocking Truth About the "Liberation of Afghanistan"**

In his 1984 book, *Red Flag Over Afghanistan*, Thomas T. Hammond writes, "...[T]he Soviet invasion of Afghanistan can be viewed as just the latest step in the centuries-old process of Russian expansion." In his book, *KGB Today: The Hidden Hand*, John Barron says that just prior to the winter of 1979, the Soviet ruling elite gathered together to decide whether or not the KGB should assassinate Afghanistan's president, Hafizullah Amin and to substitute in his stead a Soviet agent. "After studying the plan, conceived by Andropov's underlings and approved by him, the Politburo voted *da*."

The KGB then sent an assassin to kill Amin, but after several unsuccessful attempts to poison him, the Politburo and Andropov issued orders to take more aggressive action. On December 27, 1979, with backup by Soviet commandos, Colonel Bayerenov led a KGB team of assassins into President Amin's palace. Almost everyone in the palace was murdered in cold blood. Shortly thereafter, the 8 year long Afghanistan war began.

In their book *"A Nation Is Dying"*, Jeri Laber and Barnett R. Rubin recount the horrifying atrocities committed by Soviet troops and KGB agents. They cut the throats of children, shot civilians, decapitated victims, and tied dynamite to the backs of people and blew them up. They seized civilians, tied them up, piled them up like wood, poured gasoline over them and burned them alive. The victims were young and old—men, women, and children. The Russians used helicopters to drop camouflaged "butterfly" mines disguised as toys, such as dolls or trucks. When curious children picked them up the bombs would explode in their faces, blowing off their hands and arms and sometimes blinding them. Under Gorbachev's leadership, the Soviet air force flew hundreds of bombing missions every day, reducing towns and villages to piles of

rubble.<sup>178</sup>

The Russians and their ally, the U.S. ruling elite, have pursued other means to accomplish Russian expansion. According to an *Associated Press* report on November 18, 2001, titled "Afghan Opposition Agrees to UN-Sponsored Talks on Power-Sharing Government", "The United States has pressured the northern alliance to share power with other factions...and to let the United Nations oversee assembly of a new government." On November 10, 2001 President Bush had stated, "The United States will work closely with the United Nations and development banks to reconstruct Afghanistan after hostilities there have ceased.... And the United States will work with the U.N. to support a post-Taliban government...."

"The oppressive Taliban regime in Afghanistan," writes William F. Jasper, "has been replaced by an interim government composed of terrorists from the Russian- and Iranian-backed Northern Alliance, leaving the Moscow strategists to call the shots in Kabul, but in a more covert fashion than during their previous military occupation of the country.... Following in the footsteps of Team Clinton, Team Bush is proceeding to turn over this immense, strategically vital region of the world to" domination by Russia.<sup>179</sup> After inflicting death and destruction on the Afghans for over eight years, the Russians are back in Afghanistan. The Russian government, dominated by Communist criminals, the KGB Mafia mob and mass murderers, has accomplished its goal with the assistance of its ally—the Bush Administration.

In the December 31, 2001 issue of *The New American*, the Insider Report states: "Although the Russians claim that the troops are there for humanitarian purposes, journalist Eric Margolis recognized that the occupation meant that 'Moscow is now free to continue plans to dominate South and Central Asia in concert with its strategic allies, India and Iran.'"

The Security Council of the United Nations assigned an international peacekeeping force to Kabul, the Afghan capital, during the rule of the interim government. In the *New York Times*, December 20, 2001, Serge Schmemmann and Warren Hoge state, "The United Nations Security Council today authorized an international force to help keep the peace in Afghanistan.... The United Nations resolution says the force...is to maintain security in an [sic] around Kabul...." On January 25, 2002, *BBC News* reported: "Mr [sic] Annan promised that the UN would work 'hand in hand' with Afghanistan and its interim government to rebuild the country." On January 28, 2002, President Bush said, "Today, peacekeepers from around the world are helping provide security on the streets of Kabul. The United States will continue to work closely with these forces...."

On February 16, 2002, President Bush said, "[W]e liberated a people. We freed women and children from the clutches of one of the most barbaric regimes in the history of mankind. But there's more to do in Afghanistan." In Afghanistan, this administration has "liberated a people," thus assisting the Communist Party—the government of the Soviet Union—in its role of sponsoring "wars of national liberation."

As a result of Bush's "liberation" of their country, Afghans have either been killed or are now in the clutches of Russian/KGB killers. William Norman Grigg and Jennifer A. Gritt note that University of New Hampshire Professor Marc W. Herold "compiled a civilian death toll of 3,767 Afghans for the first two months of the military campaign...." "What causes the documented high level of civilian casualties...in the U.S. air war upon Afghanistan?" wrote Professor Herold. "The explanation is the apparent willingness of U.S. military strategists to fire missiles into, and drop bombs upon, heavily populated areas in Afghanistan."<sup>180</sup>

On March 11, 2002, President Bush said, "Six months separate us from September the 11th.... The power and vitality of our coalition have been proven in Afghanistan."

VI. The Bush Administration and Its Communist Allies: Using  
the Volatile Mixture of Utopian Slogans and the Specter of Mass Terror  
to Blast Their Way to the Final World Victory of Communism

**Like Stalin's Regime, Clinton/Bush Administrations  
Have Created "Armies" and Fought "Wars" to Solve Problems**

Seweryn Bialer states: "The style of leadership prevalent within and displayed by Soviet bureaucracies under Stalin, and especially the way in which economic management ran the economy and was in turn run by the political elite, was geared to conditions that were rightly described as those of simulated combat. The Soviet economic and political organization...began to resemble most closely a combat army in a not-too-popular war. The simulated combat conditions...found a fitting expression even in the terminology and language of official Russia, which was most closely based on military imagery."

"In Stalinist Russia," says Bialer, "one did not solve a problem, one 'attacked' it; one 'retreated,' 'regrouped,' organized a 'campaign'; one was at 'war' and organized one's own 'camp' against the 'enemy.' One acted on various 'fronts'—ideological, industrial, agricultural—and one had a 'strategy' and 'tactic' for each 'sector.' The most striking imagery was of the Communist party as an 'army,'...." Stalin expounded on the "Party's corps of generals," its "corps of officers," etc.<sup>181</sup>

In *Soviet Man*, Smirnov writes, "To instill firmness and determination one must give people a clear realisation of the fact that in Soviet society along with great achievements there are also problems that are waiting to be solved; one must give them a realistic notion of the stage of socialism that society has reached at present. Otherwise it is impossible to train the young generation ideologically and morally for active participation in the building of communism." "...[A] person's attitude to work for the good of society...is, in fact, the most essential expression of his socialist consciousness."<sup>182</sup>

The Communists have made a deliberate attempt to produce maximum chaos, deliberately and systematically creating problems such as drug abuse, poverty, illiteracy, and international terrorism. American leaders, allies of the Communists, have then waged "wars" against these Communist-created scourges, and in the name of combating drugs, poverty, terrorism, etc., they have worked constantly to expand the powers of the government. At the same time, the Clinton-Bush administrations have strived to generate *mass* collective action and *mass* organized activities by rallying "armies" of citizens to help fight these wars. In *Socialist Society*, Glezerman states, "The building of socialism and communism demands the pooling of effort by millions of working people."<sup>183</sup> By such means, these administrations have effectively carried forward their plan to replace individualism with collectivism.

Soviet and Chinese Communist drug traffickers have sought to inflict the agony of cocaine and heroin addiction upon American youth. Dr. Joseph D. Douglass Jr. states, "...The United States has been targeted as an act of war and is the victim of a long-range, sustained, vicious drug offensive...." "[D]ecades ago the Leninist strategists in China and the Soviet Union devised elaborate long-range plans to use drugs as a 'softening up' weapon in the World Revolution.... They vastly increased the world output of narcotics
